THE FRENCH STRING TRIO with GEORGES PLUDERMACHER

Twice before, in February 1973 and January 1975, Friends of Chamber Music welcomed the French String Trio to our series in Stockton. So great was the enthusiasm of our audience for these superb musicians that we have brought them back again to Stockton--this time with the addition of French pianist Georges Pludermacher.

The French String Trio was founded in 1959 and has become one of Europe's most renowned performers of chamber music.

GERARD JARRY, one of France's best known violinists, in addition to his performance schedule with the Trio, is often a guest performer with other ensembles and chamber orchestras throughout Europe. Since 1969 he has performed as soloist with the J.-F. Paillard Chamber Orchestra, with whom he has recorded all of the works for chamber orchestra by Mozart. In 1951 he won the Grand Prize at the Marguerite Long-Jacques Thibaud Competition.

SERGE COLLOT began his formal training at the Paris Conservatory, studying under such men as Maurice Vieux and Arthur Honegger. One of the original members of the Parrenin Quartet at its conception in 1942, Mr. Collot was also a moving force in the founding of "Les Concerts Du Domain Musical," consisting of a small group of musicians centering around Pierre Boulez. He is professor of viola at the Paris Conservatory.

MICHEL TOURNUS, cellist with the French String Trio, has studied cello and piano since age five. In 1949 he won First Prize at the Paris Conservatory where he studied with Pierre Fournier. He has appeared as a soloist with orchestras throughout Europe and has performed frequently on French radio and television, both as a soloist and in chamber music.

Pianist GEORGES PLUDERMACHER, 31 years of age, has appeared in France and abroad both as recitalist and in combination with other ensembles such as the Cologne Radio Orchestra, the Royal Philharmonic in London, and the Orchestra de Paris under the baton of Solti. He toured in the USA three years ago, and with Nathan Milstein in Europe, to great critical acclaim. The London Times said that Pludermacher "gives the impression of having 20 or 30 fingers rather than ten."
