- The "Secolo Barocco" was founded by Michel Debost and Amaury Wallez in 1965 and enlarged to its present status in 1969. This instrumentation allows for the performance of a diversified combination of instrumental sounds in the form of duos, trios, quartets (with or without harpsichord) and quintets. All the works performed are original scores.
- •With the exception of harpsichordist Guy Condette all artists are principals or assistant principals of the Orchestra de Paris, France's foremost symphony, and were hand-picked by Charles Munch upon creation of the orchestra among the best musicans of their generation.
- The ensemble has performed throughout Europe and Japan and also at various music festivals. They are making their first North American concert tour during the 1972-1973 season.
